Perth Children's Hospital Ward 1A Mural Artwork

The mural artwork that spans across 100 metres of wall outside patient rooms in Ward 1A came about after listening to feedback from oncology patients and families being treated on the ward.

What was once a bare grey wall has been transformed into a colourful mural that invites you to go on visual journey through a variety of natural and built landscapes, blending images of people, fauna, flora and abstraction.

We hope that this mural artwork painted by West Australian artist Kyle Hughes-Odgers in 2020 provides an uplifting environment and brightens the outlook for patients and families at Perth Children's Hospital.

This book is for you to explore the entire mural design, with opportunities to add your own artistic touches or write about the places it inspires you to travel as you let your mind wander.

The mural design presents a narrative of a young person taking a ride on a bird and going on a great adventure.


The story takes you on a journey of discovery through a variety of real and imaginary landscapes and aims to create intrigue, conversation and wonder.

The colours were inspired by the surrounding environment and complement the natural backdrop of the Kings Park bushland.




















Kyle visited patients and ran creative workshops.
