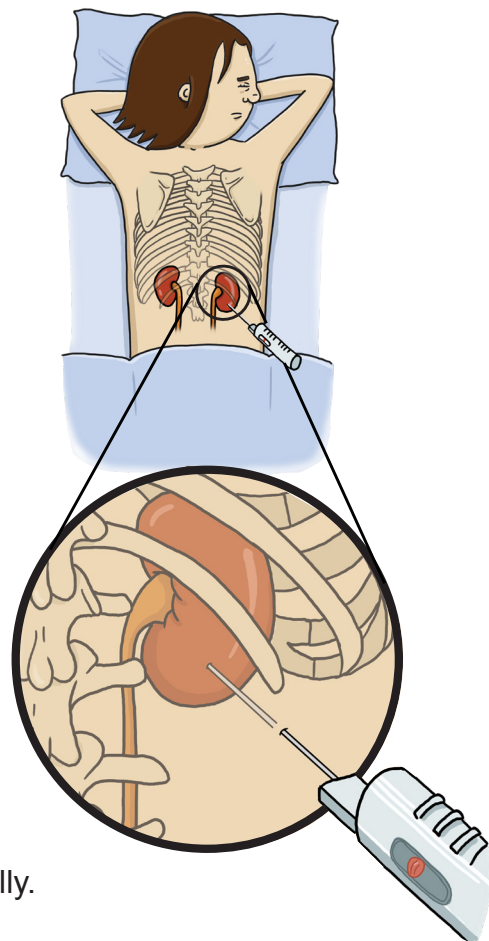




After having a  
**Renal biopsy**

Bub may feel sore for a day or 2 after the procedure. Give paracetamol (Panadol) for pain as needed follow the packet instructions.



**Paracetamol (Panadol)**



Given at:

Next dose at:

**No more than 4 times in 24 hours**

**Daily activity**

- Bub can go to school or day care after 2 days.
- No contact sports or rough play for 4 weeks.
- The doctor will let you know when it is ok for bub to play normally.

**Urine/pee**

Bub might have some blood in their urine/pee (pink in colour) for the first 24 hours after the procedure. Bub should be passing normal amounts of urine/pee.

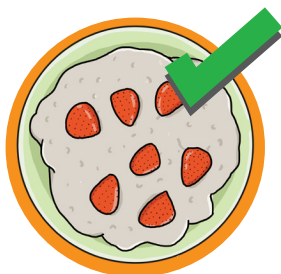
**Advice following the anaesthetic**

**Food and drink**

When bub is hungry, they should have light food like:

- a sandwich, eggs or porridge.

No greasy or fried foods straight after procedure. They can have usual food the next day.



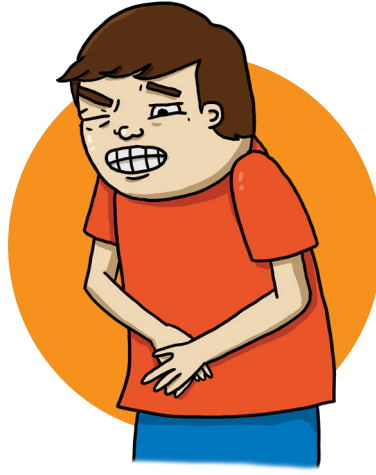
## Vomiting

If bub vomits, no food or drink for half an hour, then start sips of water and slowly give more and more. If vomiting continues see a GP or health clinic.

Go to the emergency department if bub has:



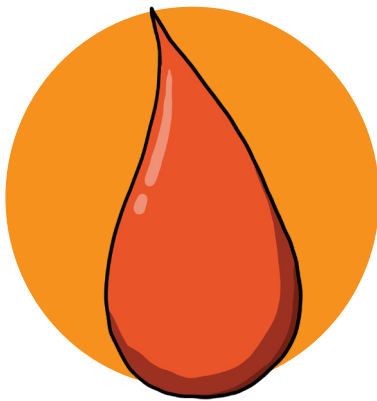
A fever



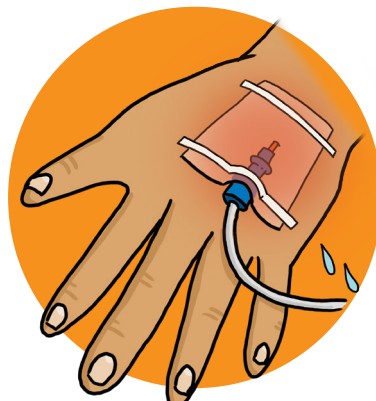
More pain around the biopsy site or their tummy



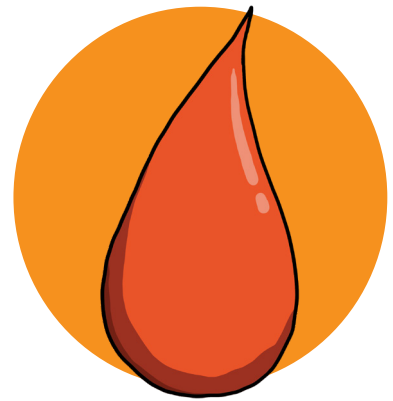
Pale and sweaty skin



Dark blood in their urine/pee



Swelling, pain and redness on hand where IV was



Fresh bleeding or ooze from the biopsy site when changing bub's dressing the next day
