You can watch television, play games, see information about the hospital, and even order your own meals on your Patient Entertainment System (PES).




Tip

Your PES remote

You can navigate the PES using your remote control.



Attention

You should see your first and last name on screen when you first use your PES. Please contact ward staff if your name is missing or incorrect.

Ordering your meals

You can order your meals for today and tomorrow using your PES remote by selecting the “Order a Meal” option in the main menu. Your menu is specially customised to suit your diet and allergies.

If you forget to order a meal before the cut-off time, don't worry! You will be delivered a suitable surprise meal at mealtime. navigate the PES using your remote control.
