

COMMUNIQUE CHILD AND ADOLESCENT HEALTH SERVICE BOARD FEBRUARY 2023

This Communique highlights key discussion from the Child and Adolescent Health Service (CAHS) Board's February 2023 meeting as well as other important information.

The first Board meeting for 2023 was held on 2 February 2023 at Perth Children's Hospital Boardroom and via MS Teams

The Board acknowledged and extended congratulations to CAHS and WA Health staff for the following awards:

Long Service Award:

Australia Day honours recipients:

- Dr David Russell-Weisz, Director General, for outstanding public service through leadership and management in response to the COVID-19 pandemic;
- Dr Geoff Dobb, past Board Member, for significant service to intensive care medicine and to professional associations;
- Ms Sue Kiely, EDCH, for outstanding public service through the delivery of the Western Australian COVID-19 Vaccination Program; and
- Prof Helen Milroy, CAHS Consultant, for significant service to public health, and to the Indigenous community.

Consumer Engagement

The minutes of the Youth Advisory Committee and Consumer Advisory Committee were noted including key issues regarding School Health Nurse allocation, security guards in PCH and PCH signage. The Board discussed the Complaints and Compliments report as tabled.

Multicultural Action Plan

The Board noted and discussed the progress against the implementation of the Multicultural Action Plan with further progress to be provided to the People, Culture and Capability Committee quarterly.

CAHS Disability Access and Inclusion Plan

The Board noted the progress report for CAHS Disability Access and Inclusion Plan and discussed transition services for adolescents and young adults with complex conditions from paediatric to adult health services.

Safety & Quality

The Board discussed the clinical incidents and updates regarding Lessons Learned Framework with

a focus on significance of sharing lessons learned across the organization, including via Safety and Quality Newsletter.

Women and Newborns Relocation Project

The Board noted a presentation about the Women and Newborns Relocation Project and discussed facility management and operation matters.
