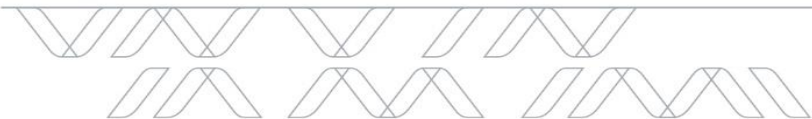
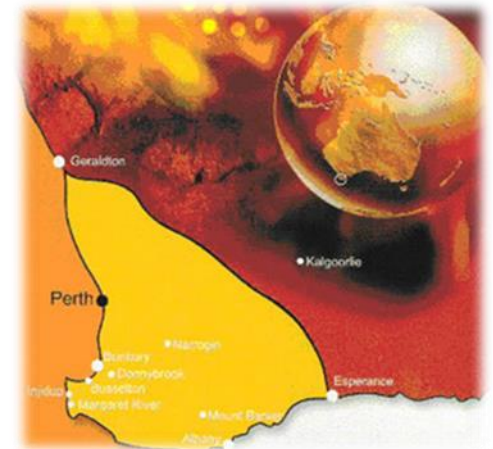


Acknowledgement of Traditional Land Owners

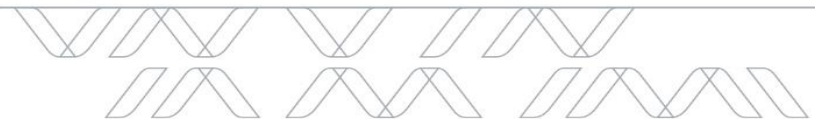

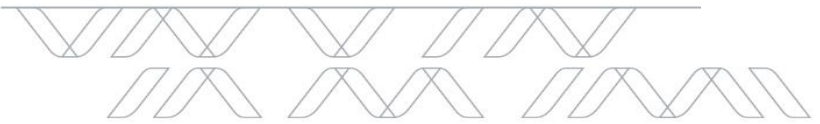

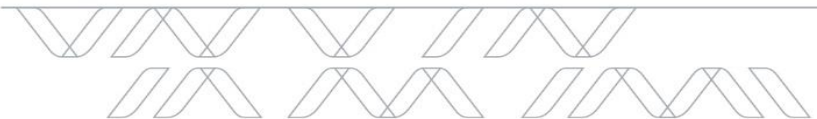


SCGOPHCG Nursing Professional Practice Model



Program Details

- The SCGOPHCG Graduate Nurse Program aims to support the transition of the newly qualified nurse into the clinical areas, developing their expertise and integration into the nursing workforce at SCGH & OPH.
- Our programs will build your confidence using the knowledge that you have gained in your undergraduate or vocational program, to facilitate your transition from beginner to competent nurse.

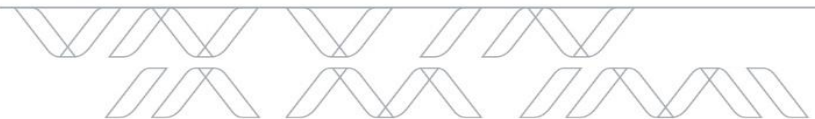
- Recruitment for Osborne Park and Sir Charles Gairdner Hospitals
- 6-month, 12-month, 18-month & 24-month contracts available
- 4 intakes in the upcoming recruitment process for **EN's & RN's** :
August 2025 or October 2025 &
February 2026 or April 2026

- Majority 12-month rotations : 2 x 6-month rotations across SCGH or OPH or combination of both sites

For the 12month program ALL wards at both sites support NQN rotations including speciality areas (ED, ICU, CCU, CVIL, HomeLink, Outpatients etc)

- 12-month RN theatre program available at OPH. Must live within 30mins due to on call requirements
- 24-month RN theatre program available at SCGH, only available August 2025 & February 2026 intakes.

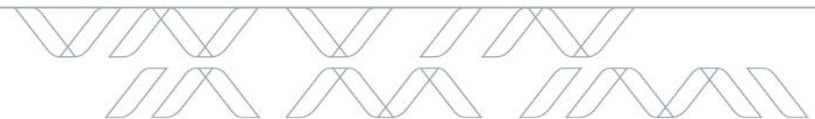

(available only for August 2025 and February 2026 intakes)

- Part time program (48hrs : 6 shifts F/n) available on selected wards

This includes 3 x 6month rotations, with the last rotation in ED

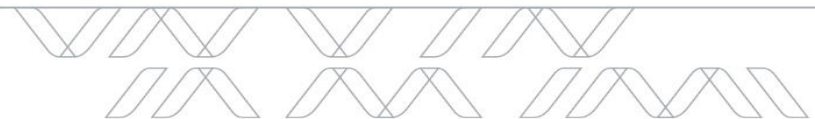
- **18-month ICU pathway**

This includes 3 x 6month rotations, with the last rotation in ICU

- **18-month cancer pathway**

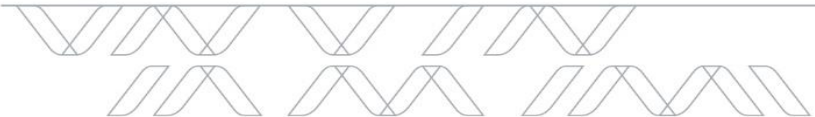
This includes 3 x 6month rotations, including combination of G73 Oncology

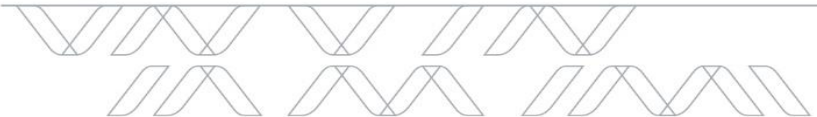
- Supported supernumerary days each rotation

Combined Mental Health Program

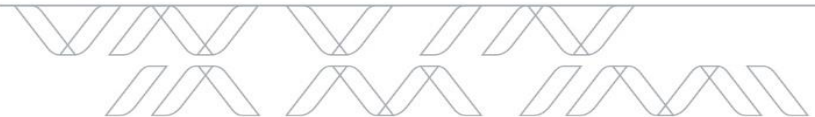
- August 2025 and February 2026 intakes
- 6 months general ward (SCGH or OPH) and 6 months NMHS mental health
- Supported supernumerary days each rotation
- Graylands, MHU (UU Block), MHOA (G Block), OPH Mental Health
- Select **NMHS: Mental health/ SCGOPHCG Combined** as your 1st preference if you want this program



NQN program SDN's (GPS)

The Need to Learn With Support: GPS – there to support you on the floor

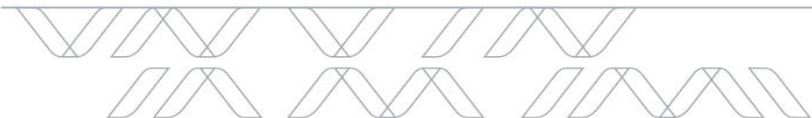
- Clinical supervision, support and facilitation of clinical skill acquisition
- Application of theory to practice and fostering critical thinking
- Liaising closely with the staff in the clinical setting to provide appropriate learning opportunities and liaising with other suitable clinical staff that may assess particular aspects of your clinical practice
- Facilitation graduate specific induction, Clinical Development Seminars and Professional Development study days



About Sir Charles Gairdner Hospital (SCGH)



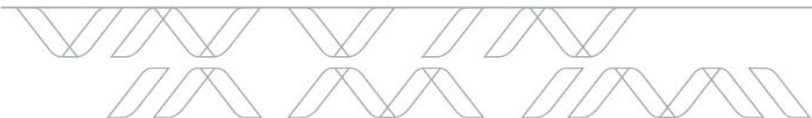
- Fully accredited Teaching Hospital, 15 minutes away from the CBD

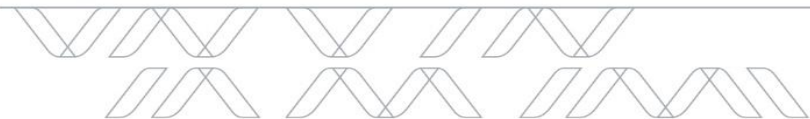
- **Ward 2** – Stroke Unit

- Electrolyte Imbalance

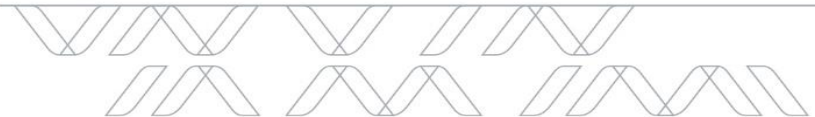
- **Ward 5** – Acute Medical

How to Apply...

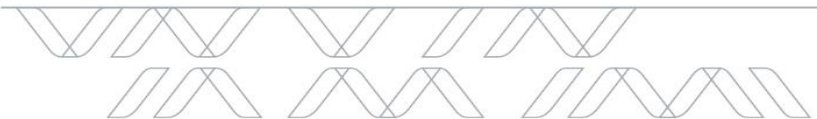


1. Grad Connect opens **24 Feb 2025**
2. **Select NMHS: SCGOPHCG** on grad connect as your **1st preference** . This includes all our programs we offer except mental health/ SCGOPHCG combined program
3. Once GradConnect closes, ALL first round applications are swept to us
4. ALL applicants are then sent a questionnaire/survey where they rank start date, site (OPH/ SCGH) etc
5. Ward preferences including specialty areas (ED, ICU etc) will happen after interview once you have been successful in gaining a position



Post Program Employment

- Lots of employment opportunities available post program, we want you to stay!!
- At approx. 9 month mark of program a post program employment process will take place for all graduates
- Permanent or Fixed term contracts available

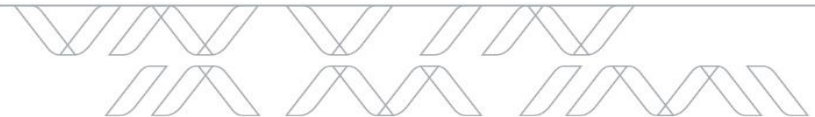
