

Stan Perron Immunisation Centre

Did you know that the Perth Children's Hospital has an immunisation centre for children?

Immunisation is a safe and effective way of protecting against harmful diseases. All children and their families visiting Perth Children's Hospital (PCH) can drop-in to the Stan Perron Immunisation Centre for routine immunisations.

The service is free of charge. No appointment or referral is necessary.

If your child is due or overdue a vaccination, next time you visit PCH, drop-in to the immunisation centre before you leave.

Where is the immunisation centre?

The Stan Perron Immunisation Centre is located at PCH on Level 1, Clinic D, which you can access via the Pink or Yellow Lifts. Tell the clerk at the reception desk you are there to attend the Immunisation centre.

Hours of operation

The centre operates from 8.30am to 12pm and 1pm to 4pm, Monday to Friday. It is closed on public holidays.
