

Prescription glasses

Your child has been prescribed glasses by the Ophthalmology outpatient service at Child and Adolescent Health Service.

As the holder of a pension or health care card, your first prescription per calendar year is provided free of charge. Replacement prescriptions will not be supplied.

We want to continue providing this service to as many children as possible.

You can help by encouraging your child to take reasonable care when handling their glasses. Replacement glasses will not be provided by the hospital for breakage or loss of glasses.

In the event of damage to glasses, the Child and Adolescent Health Service does not provide a repair service.
