
I need an abdominal ultrasound




My doctor/nurse has told me that I need an ultrasound of my tummy.



The ultrasound will give the doctor a picture of what is inside my tummy.



If my tummy hurts, I can have medicine before I have my ultrasound.




I will need to go to the Medical Imaging department with my parent/caregiver to have my ultrasound. This is close to ED.



I will need to lie on the bed and lift up my shirt so the sonographer can see my tummy.



The sonographer will put gel on the ultrasound probe and place it on my tummy. This helps get a clear picture of what is going on.





My job is to keep still even though it feels different. I can take something with me to keep me busy (e.g. my device).

My parent/carer can stay with me.



Now that the job is finished, it's time to go back to ED and wait for my doctor to tell me what the picture showed.
